**RESOLUTION:** Government is pleased to approve the following rules for recruitment to non-gazetted post of Head Draftsman in the Bureau of Economics and Statistics, Bombay.

"Head Draftsman"

Appointment shall be made by the Director, Bureau of Economics and Statistics, Bombay, by promotion from amongst the Draftsman of proved merit with at least 3 years experience as Draftsman in the Bureau of Economics and Statistics.

Failing such a suitable candidate being available for promotion, appointment shall be made by the Director by nomination from amongst candidates who:

(a) if not already in Government service are not less than 10 years and not more than 25 years of age;

(b) possess a Government Diploma in Arts in any of the Technical Trades preferably in Commercial Trade and have not less than three years experience as Draftsman in any Government Office or a reputed private concern."

2. The Political and Services Department should be requested to incorporate the recruitment rule in Appendix 'D' of Bombay Civil Services classification and Recruitment Rules in due course.

22 (10) Draughtsman:

Appointments shall be made by the Director, Bureau of Economic and Statistics, Bombay by nomination from among candidates who (i) if not-already in Government Service, are not less 18 years and not more than 25 years of age, (ii) possess a Government Diploman in Arts in any of the Technical Trades, preferably in Commercial Trade.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF CLERK, CLERK-TYPIST, T  
G.R., G.A.D.No.RTR-1064-J, dated 16th September, 1964

Appointments shall be made by nomination on the result of a competitive examination held by the Commission :

Provided that suitable members of Class IV service are substantive members of that Service and who while in that service have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination or an examination recognised by Government as equivalent to that examination, shall be eligible for appointment to the posts of clerks by promotion.

(2) To be eligible for appointment by nomination, candidate must :-

(1) have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination or an examination recognised by Government as equivalent to that examination :

(ii) have attained the age of 18 years and not have attained the age of 23 years on the first day of the month immediately following the month in which the posts are advertised to the Commission :

Provided that the upper age limit will be relaxed to 26 years in the case of Class IV servants who have passed S.S.C. or an equivalent examination while in service and have in not less than two years' continuous service in an office of the Government of Maharashtra.

A candidate for the posts of Clerk-Typist or Typist must also be able to type neatly and accurately at a minimum speed of 40 words per minute.
